Tired of walking we hopped on one of the many tractor drawn trams.



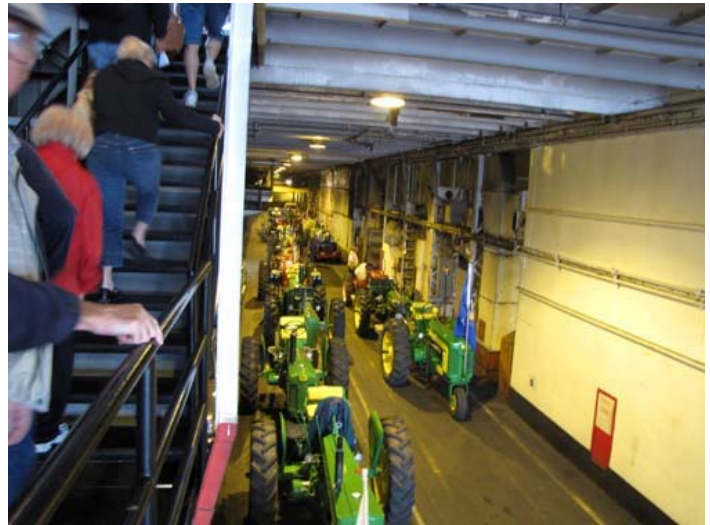
Leaving the tram, we crossed the taxi way and decided to venture into the warbird parking area.
